



Saint Paul

Paul was known as Saul of Tarsus before his conversion. He embarked on three missionary journeys that took him to Syria, Cyprus, Asia Minor, Macedonia, Greece and elsewhere.

He is the traditional author of 14 of the Epistles. Paul was martyred in Rome, probably by beheading (a concession to his Roman citizenship). In 68 A.D. Paul spoke of the word of God as the "Sword of the Spirit". The window depicts symbols of the sword and the open Bible.

St. Paul's Feast Day is June 29.
